Job Description for Youth Director

- 1. The Youth Director must be a Christian with a definite sense of personal experience with Christ.
- 2. Must feel comfortable with all age groups, including working with parents of youth.
- 3. Must be willing to attend and support the ministries of Cameron Baptist Church.
- 4. Must be willing to submit to background checks for criminal record.
- 5. Will be required to obtain CDL within 6 months of hire date.
- 6. Must be willing to work with Pastor as direct supervisor and personnel committee as employer representatives.

Specific Expectations

- 1. Will prepare and carry out youth meetings for recreation and Bible Study once per week. (Approx. 3-5 hours)
- 2. Will plan and carry out youth Sunday one Sunday during the Spring or Summer, wherein the youth will be involved in the service.
- 3. Will coordinate teaching opportunities with the current youth Sunday school teacher when not teaching.
- 4. Will be expected to cultivate personal relationships with youth and children and encouraged to follow those up with visitations.
- 5. Will be expected to cultivate relationships with families, including recruiting parents to chaperone and help with meetings and events.
- 6. Will plan and carry out a summer trip for the youth and other summer recreation trips for the youth, expenses will be covered by the Church for required trips.
- 7. Will encourage interaction between the adult church members and the youth and children by encouraging youth involvement in church activities and church member involvement in youth activities.
- 8. Will received 4 paid days annually.
